

Year 7 catch up:

Students eligible for catch up support in year 7 have received interventions to support them in targeting and developing weaker areas of their learning.

- Small groups of students have been working with an English specialist in 3 tutor sessions a week to develop their reading and writing skills which will support them with their learning in lessons.
- Small groups of students have been working with a Maths specialist in 3 tutor sessions a week to develop basic maths skills and weaker areas of learning.
- A targeted group of students have been receiving extra one hour Maths and English sessions outside of their regular timetabled lessons to develop identified weaker areas of knowledge. This has been small group work intervention with specialist teachers in order to support the learning within the regular classroom setting.
- A selected group of students have been receiving extra reading support on a weekly basis to develop reading fluency and understanding.
- A selected group of students will be taking part in an English focus breakout day offsite where they will take part in an enrichment activity and will then use this experience in an academic English activity- **Postponed until early 20/21 due to coronavirus school closures.**
- A selected group of students will be taking part in a Maths focus breakout day offsite where they will take part in an enrichment activity and will then use this experience in an academic Maths activity- **Postponed until early 20/21 due to coronavirus school closures.**
